Eastern wall:

In the centre:

Equestrian portrait of Stanisław Kostka Potocki, painted by Jacques-Louis David, 1781.

On the right:

Portrait of Aleksander Potocki (son of Stanisław Kostka Potocki, successive owner of Wilanów), painted by Aleksander Kokular, 1841.

Portrait of Natalia Sanguszkowa née Potocka (daughter of Aleksander Potocki from his marriage with Anna Tyszkiewicz), painted by Johann Ender, 1829.

On the left:

Portrait of Aleksandra Augustowa Potocka (wife of August Potocki, successive owner of Wilanów, together with her husband), painted by Friedrich von Amerling, 19th cent. **Portrait of August Potocki** (son of Aleksander Potocki, successive owner of Wilanów, together with his wife Aleksandra), painted by Johann Ender, 1829.

Northern wall:

Upper row from left to right:

Portrait of King Jan III with his eldest son Jakub, painted by Jerzy Eleuter Szymonowicz-Siemiginowski, ca. 1690.

Portrait of Queen Maria Casimire with her daughter Teresa Kunegunda, painted by Jerzy Eleuter Szymonowicz- Siemiginowski, ca. 1690.

Portrait of Queen Eleanor of Austria (wife of King Michał Korybut Wiśniowiecki), unknown painter, 1670-1675.

Portrait of King Augustus III, painted by Louis de Silvestre, before 1752.

Portrait of Queen Maria Josepha (spouse of August III), painted by Louis de Silvestre, after 1737.

Bottom row from left to right:

Portrait of King Augustus II, painted by Louis de Silvestre (studio), ca. 1737.

Portrait of King Sigismund III, court painter, ca. 1630.

Portrait of Queen Marie Louise (wife of Władysław IV, then of Jan Kazimierz), painted by Peter Danckers de Rij, after mid-17th cent.

Portrait of King Jan II Casimir, unknown painter, 2nd half of the 17th cent.

Portrait of King Augustus III, painted by Louis de Silvestre (studio), 1737.

Western wall:

In the central place, from November onward, we are going to present a **Portrait of Jan III Sobieski**, painted by Andreas Stech or Jerzy Eleuter Szymonowicz-Siemiginowski, 1680-1690. The portrait is currently under conservation at the National Museum in Warsaw and, from 7 July to 1 November, it will be possible to admire it at the exhibition "Jan III Sobieski. The Polish King in Vienna" in the Winter Palace of Prince Eugene of Savoy in Vienna.

Portrait of Aleksander Benedykt Sobieski (son of Jan III), painted by Jerzy Eleuter Szymonowicz-Siemiginowski, ca. 1690.

Portrait of Konstantyn Władysław Sobieski (son of Jan III), painted by Jerzy Eleuter Szymonowicz-Siemiginowski, ca. 1690.

Lower row.

Portrait of James Edward Stuart (spouse of Maria Klementyna Sobieska, pretender to the throne of Scotland and England), painted by Joseph Bolzern (?), copy from François de Troy; 1858. **Portrait of Maria Klementyna Sobieska (?)** (daughter of Jakub Ludwik Sobieski, granddaughter of Jan III); painter unknown, 18th cent.
